Environment and Maintenance

- Update report from Predator Free-Les. Background trapping has reported 36 kills for January and February, so a really good start for the year.
- Update report from Chris re:dotterels. It has been another successful breeding season for our Onemana Dotterels (7 fledged chicks) and Variable Oyster Catchers (2 fledged).
- I am grateful to the local community who are generally becoming more interested and helpful with the nests and chicks. Also this year, the dog owners have mostly complied with the dog restrictions which has also been really pleasing.
- 2 more Dog signs requested from TCDC for the 2 tracks by the surf club which don't have any official signs. Also messaged them about the dog information sign in the playground carpark which is too low down and unable to be seen when a car parks in front of it. Rob followed up with monthly action list to TCDC.
- Rob will continue with monthly list and update to Eileen Hopping (TCDC).
- Bruce, Rob & Rod moved the mulch to Arthurs pass as bee was cancelled, Whitipirorua corner has been completed for Beach Hop, Kathryn & Bruce have been taking care of weeds.
